BACKGROUND

The Mo Beef Kids (MBK) team will be selecting a limited number of 4-H and FFA members across the state to participate in leadership and educational opportunities, while representing the Missouri Beef Checkoff, and MBK program in their communities.

Selected students will gain knowledge around the beef industry, program mission and education outreach. Typed applications must be received by April 15, 2024, accompanied by a letter of recommendation and resume. Submit to luella@beef.school. Virtual interviews will be conducted with selected finalists. More information will be provided upon submission.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be an incoming junior or senior high school student and at least 16 years of age.
- Selected students will be required to complete the Masters of Beef Advocacy program, an online advocacy program offered by the National Cattlemen's Beef Board.
- Selected students will be an ambassador for the MBK program and beef industry in their community and will attend meetings or kickoff events to aide in program support.
- Students will be required to attend a one-day training in Columbia on July 28, focused on the MBK program, academy responsibilities, consumer advocacy, and checkoff education.
- Academy members attend Cattlemen's Convention at Osage Beach, fun and educational trips across the state, and participate in policy and advocacy events (Busch Stadium, St. Louis University, etc.)
- This role will begin July 1, 2024 and conclude May 31, 2025. Send typed application and questions to luella@beef.school.
